## April 3 Don't Be Unfruitful in God's Vineyard!

My beloved had a vineyard on a very fruitful hill. He dug it up, gathered out its stones, planted it with the choicest vine, built a tower in its midst, and also cut out a winepress therein. He looked for it to yield grapes, but it yielded wild grapes. — Isaiah 5:1-2
