The Amazon River

On this extraordinary journey aboard the deluxe Delfin II into one of the most biologically diverse places on earth, watch scarlet macaws winging overhead, pink dolphins swimming in dark waters, and chattering troops of monkeys foraging in the trees. During the day, venture into the Pacaya Samiria Reserve; in the evening, attend a lecture, relax in the lounge, or listen to the sounds of the rainforest at night.

Day 1: U.S. / Lima, Peru

After a late arrival in Lima, Peru, transfer to the Country Club Hotel, one of the finest hotels in the city.

Day 2: Lima

After a leisurely breakfast, take a city tour of Lima, including the Huallamarca, a restored pre-Columbian pyramid, and the Larco Herrera Museum. After lunch at the museum, return to the hotel to relax before your welcome dinner this evening. (B,L,D)

Day 3: Lima /Iquitos/ Delfin II

This morning visit Real Felipe Fortress in El Callao province and stop for a brief visit at a local school before heading to the airport for the flight to Iquitos. In Iquitos, take a scenic bus ride to Nauta, where

you will embark the Delfin II. (B,L,D)

Day 4: Belluda Caño & El Dorado River / Pacaya Samiria Reserve

This morning we board our excursion boats and set off to explore the beautiful, black-water Belluda Stream, a preferred habitat for pink dolphins. Also keep a lookout for squirrel monkeys, saddleback tamarins, pygmy kingfishers. After lunch on board, head out again mid-afternoon for the El Dorado River to look for more wildlife. (B,L,D)

Day 5: Puinahua and Pacaya Rivers

Today we enter the Puinahua River to search for poison dart frogs en route to a local ribereno village.

After lunch on board, head out for the Pacaya River, where you might see large troops of red howler, monk saki, brown capuchin, and tamarins, as well as colorful macaws. (B,L,D)

Day 6: Caro Curahuayte / Yanallpa Village

This morning, head out on our skiffs to Caro Curahuayte to fish for piranhas. This afternoon, visit the riverside community of Yanallpa to meet local villagers. Enjoy a farewell dinner on board this eve-

ning as the ship turns to make its homeward journey downriver to Iquitos. (B,L,D)

Day 7: Amazon River/ Iquitos / Lima / flights home

This morning board the excursion boats for a last chance to enjoy the river and rainforest, as well as a visit to the village of Puerto Miguel. After lunch on board, transfer to Iquitos for the flight to Lima, and connect with homeward flights to the U.S. (B,L)
