Based at *Casa Artom*, this 4 week program takes you out of the classroom and into a new learning experience! This special version of Anthropology's popular divisional/CD course *Peoples and Cultures of the World* takes advantage of the historical and archaeological context of Venice by adding historical time depth, followed by a focus on contemporary Italy and its immigrant populations. On-site presentations at the city and region's historical sites provide the cultural and environmental history of the area. Field experiences illustrate the cultural diversity of contemporary Italy, including how the nation is coping with the influx of migrants from the Mediterranean and Africa. (3hr; D, CD)
