What is Mentoring?

The concept of mentoring is by no means a recent phenomenon. The word itself, simply defined by the Oxford American Dictionary as “a trusted adviser,” finds its origins in ancient Greece. In the *Odyssey*, Mentor is the name of the trusted friend who in Ulysees’ absence protects, nurtures, educates and guides his son Telemachus into adulthood.

The basic mentoring relationship is simply friendship with someone a little more experienced, a person who acts as a guide in regard to vocational discernment and spiritual formation; provides counsel and pastoral support in times of crisis; and most important, helps the mentee recognize the already present action of God in his/her life.

Who is the Mentee?
