

## SEMINARY/DIVINITY SCHOOL ROAD TRIPS

The Office of the Chaplain has monies available for Wake Forest juniors and seniors considering a theological education who wish to visit divinity schools and/or seminaries. Students may fill out an application, which will then be reviewed by the Office of the Chaplain. Students are encouraged to go with other Wake Forest students and to arrange housing with the schools being visited. Monies are available to assist with travel expenses, meals, and housing. Each student receiving assistance from these funds will be asked to write a report and to debrief with one of the chaplains upon his/her return. Monies will be awarded on a first-come/first-served basis until the funding is depleted.
