

New Member Education Policies and Programs

- ❖ Each chapter will submit their statement of new member education objectives and expectations and a detailed list of new member activities to the Office of Greek Life by 5pm on the first Monday of the New Member Education period.
- ❖ Each Chapter will review with its members and new members the Universities Policy on Hazing (** see most current Student Handbook) and have the chapter officers and new members sign the *Statement of Understanding of Willingness to Abide by University Hazing Policies*. This statement is to be returned to the Office of Greek Life by the second Friday of the New Member Education process, or the group will be referred to the Dean of Student Services.
- ❖ Each chapter will return a completed roster for the current semester by the second Friday of the New Member Education process.
- ❖ Each chapter will ensure that all of its new members/associate members participate in the Alpha Series programs. If a new member is unable to attend this event, it is the responsibility of the chapter to identify an intellectual or cultural activity to replace this event. The Alpha Series is an educational program cosponsored by the Office of Residence Life and Housing / Greek Life and the IFC and Panhellenic Council.
- ❖ Each Panhellenic Sorority will ensure that all member/new member activities are completed within a six-week period during the semester.
- ❖ Each IFC Fraternity will ensure that all new member/associate member activities are completed within a six-week period during the semester.
- ❖ Written verification of initiation date is due in the Office of Residence Life and Housing / Greek Life for both IFC fraternities and Panhellenic sororities.
