

## **Post Function Clean-up**

### A. CLEANUP PRACTICE FOR LOUNGE LEASE ORGANIZATIONS

- 1) Immediately after a party and during non-party times, all beer containers (CUPS, BOTTLES, CANS) must be picked up and stored in closed containers. Sufficient airing must take place to eliminate the odor of beer.
- 2) The following day clean-up must include thorough mopping, disinfecting and deodorizing as well as reporting of any damages or needed repairs.
- 3) The time limit for party clean-up will be 12:00 p.m. on the following day.
- 4) A Host organization must properly clean in and around the area (up to fifty feet away) where a social function has been held.

### B. CLEANUP PRACTICES FOR NON-LOUNGE LEASE ORGANIZATIONS

- 1) Immediately after the party all beer and beverage containers (CUPS, BOTTLES, CANS) must be picked up and stored in closed containers. Sufficient airing must take place to eliminate the odor of beer. Liquid spillage must be mopped from all floors.
- 2) The following day clean-up must include thorough mopping, disinfecting and deodorizing as well as reporting of any damages to facilities that occurred as a result of the event.
- 3) The time limit for all party clean-up is 12:00 p.m. the following day.

### C. ENFORCEMENT

- 1) Non-compliance of the lounge appearance guidelines will result in a written warning from the Hall Director and/or the Greek Lounge Inspector, and may result in future loss of privilege in obtaining registration approval by the Director and Coordinator of Greek Life.
- 2) Groups will be assessed appropriate fines for failing to adhere to the above guidelines and may receive additional administration/judicial sanctions.
