SUBJECT: Long Term Care Insurance and a New Credit Union

1. Faculty and staff can now take advantage of two new benefits: Group Long Term Care Insurance and the affiliation with Allegacy Federal Credit Union.
2. **Long-Term Care Insurance**
 - a. This voluntary benefit is provided by John Hancock, for you and your spouse/domestic partner, through payroll deduction. Coverage for parents, parents-in-law, grandparents and grandparents-in-law is available through direct billing.
 - b. Long-term care provides coverage for nursing home, alternate care facilities, home health care/adult day care and informal care. Frequently, it is needed because of a medical problem, but often encompasses service beyond those covered by most medical plans.
 - c. Personalized rate quote letters were mailed last week to your home address. If you would like to request enrollment materials for yourself or other eligible family members, please call the John Hancock Customer Service Center at 1-800-482-0022.

3. **Allegacy Federal Credit Union**
 - a. Effective immediately, faculty, staff, and student workers of the University are eligible to join Allegacy. In the near future, you will receive a letter at your home address detailing additional information regarding Allegacy's range of financial services. During the month of March, representatives will be at various locations on campus to answer any questions and to help with membership enrollment.
 - b. If you are currently a member of Summit Credit Union, you may continue your membership.
