ISLI offers Spanish 153S and Spanish 212

Spanish 153S is an accelerated five-week course in an immersion setting. This course is ideal for students who wish to develop a greater confidence in Spanish in a short period of time. (5h)

Spanish 212 fulfills the University's foreign language requirement in Spanish. It's an Exploration of significant cultural expressions from the Spanish-speaking world. (3h)

Purpose

Students develop intermediate proficiency in speaking, listening, reading, and writing. Through immersion in language and cultural experiences, students increase their confidence and improve their listening and speaking skills. A low faculty/student ratio, with three instructors and never more than ten students per class, allows for highly individualized instruction and an atmosphere for successful learning.

Pre-requisite

Due to the intensive nature of the program, only Spa 111 (or equivalent) is a pre-requisite, though Spa 112 (or equivalent) is highly recommended. Permission of instructor is also acceptable. The application process requires an interview with the Program Director and attendance to two informational meetings before classes start.

Class Format

Daily classes, six hours per day.
One-hour daily lunches with instructors.
Two-hour extra-curricular activities, two evenings per week, and two Saturdays.
Pledge to speak the target language.
IBM laptop. WFU internet account.

Opportunities

Finish the WFU basic requirement in half of the time without any prior knowledge of Spanish!



Within a year, spend a semester in a Spanish-speaking country even if you have not taken Spanish before! You can be in Salamanca while students following the traditional route are still on campus taking SPA 212 or SPA 213!
