## ISLI offers Spanish 153S

Spanish 153S is an accelerated five-week course in an immersion setting. This course is ideal for students who wish to develop a greater confidence in Spanish in a short period of time and who want to get AP credit (5).

## Purpose

Students develop intermediate proficiency in speaking, listening, reading, and writing. Through immersion in language and cultural experiences, students increase their confidence and improve their listening and speaking skills. A low faculty/student ratio, with three instructors and never more than ten students per class, allows for highly individualized instruction and an atmosphere for successful learning.

## Class Format

Daily classes, four hours per day.  
One-hour daily lunches with instructors.  
One-hour extra-curricular activities,  
two evenings per week, and two Saturdays.  
Pledge to speak the target language.  
IBM laptop. WFU internet account.
