Frequently Asked Questions

Do I have to enter the military after I graduate?
Not if you're a freshman or sophomore. You can take the classes for graduation credit during those years with absolutely no obligation to the Army. Only Scholarship and Contracted Advanced Course Cadets incur an obligation.

How much credit are the classes worth?

All class are worth 3 hrs except for the freshman fall class. Junior and senior classes are worth three credit hours apiece.

What sort of "Army-style" training do you do?

Helicopter-borne training missions, live-fire rifle ranges, land navigation & map reading, squad-on-squad paintball and practical leadership exercises. All with-out a commitment.

I want a scholarship, but what if I don't want a career in the Army?

You can join the U.S. Army Reserve or your State's National Guard immediately after college, and start "one weekend a month, two weeks a year" right away. Cadets bound for the Reserves apply for civilian jobs during senior year just like other college students.

Do I need to buy books or equipment?

No. Whether you're on scholarship or just participating, there is no need to buy anything in order to take these classes.

What's the obligation?

Scholarship and contracted Advanced Course Cadets incur a service obligation of four years in active duty or six years in the Army Reserve or Army National Guard. After the initial service obligation you are given the option of continuing your career or going into the inactive ready reserve until you have reached eight years of service.
