



# What is Adaptive Release??

Adaptive Release allows the instructor to make the course content available to students based on various rules they have set up: review status of other content, scores on assignments or quizzes, group memberships, etc. Three different forms of Adaptive Release can be set up by the instructor:

1. **Adaptive Release** – Lets you set up a single, basic release rule for the item or folder. This is how you release content to a particular student or group, and where you can make the viewing of an item dependent on a score on a test or the review of another item in the course.
2. **Adaptive Release: Advanced** – Let's you set up more complex release rules for the item or folder. This allows the user to set up different rules for different groups of users or situations.
3. **Review Status** – Let's you enable a "review" requirement for this item or folder. That means that students have to mark the item as reviewed once they look at it. When review status is set on an item it applies to all users who can see the item.

<p>From the <b>Course Control Panel</b> click on any content area (i.e. Course Documents, etc)</p>	
<p>Click on the <b>Manage</b> button associated with the item you wish to view the adaptive release information for.</p>	
<p>Click on <b>Adaptive Release</b> to create, view or modify the basic release rule for this item or folder.</p>	
<p>Click on <b>Adaptive Release: Advanced</b> to create, view or modify more complex rules.</p>	
<p>Click on <b>Review Status</b> to view, modify or enable the review requirement for this item.</p>	
<p>Click on <b>Adaptive Release and Review Status: User Progress</b> to view the visibility and review status of this item or folder for each student.</p>
