

Microsoft Campus Agreement Subscription
Student Users Acceptance Form

This acceptance form is valid for the Microsoft products listed below, which shall be referred to collectively herein as the “Software”. Software is made available to you because Wake Forest University has purchased temporary licenses for the Software through Microsoft Campus Subscription Enrollment effective 2006-08-01 through 2009-07-31. Wake Forest University is extending to you the right to use the Software on an institution-owned computer designated for your exclusive use. You do not own the license or the CDs; rather you are authorized to use the Software and associated media pursuant to the terms and conditions of the license(s) granted to Wake Forest University for the term of Wake Forest University’s Campus Subscription Enrollment. You will be required to remove the Software from your personal machine immediately upon the earlier of (a) any event, with the exception of graduation, which causes you no longer to be a student of the institution or (b) expiration of the Campus Subscription Enrollment licensed period.

If you graduate during the Campus Agreement Subscription term, the Software license will convert to a perpetual license (meaning you own the Software) as verified in your Student License Confirmation, which may be obtained from Wake Forest University at that time. The Student License Confirmation is proof of Software ownership.
