

The Teaching and Learning Center's Faculty Teaching Initiative Fund

Faculty Teaching Initiative Fund is intended primarily for the development of new and innovative courses, and the significant revising of existing courses. Secondly, the Fund may be used to attend workshops or other productions that will enhance the teaching of faculty members. The Fund will not be awarded if the proposal focuses primarily on the research, writing, and artistic activities of faculty members.

Faculty Teaching Initiative Funds award up to \$2,000 that support small scholarly, pedagogical and creative efforts that facilitate academic excellence. All faculty are invited to submit a 2 page proposal that: describes the actual project and its intellectual significance; details anticipated participants and commitments already secured; explains goals and expected outcomes. A third page should contain a clearly laid-out budget.

The proposal must be signed by the dean or the applicant's chair if submitted from a College faculty member. Before consideration can be made, an Applicant must first apply for the Teaching and Learning Center's Course Development Grant.
